It is notified that the application for Review of results (applicable for theory papers only) must be submitted on or before 3rd May, 2024 from 12 Noon to 2 PM (Except Holidays) at the Office of the Controller of Examinations. The application form (Rs. 20/-) may be obtained from the Office of the Controller of Examinations from 20th April to 3rd May, 2024 from 12 Noon to 2 PM (Except Holidays).

Candidates are required to pay for Review of Answer Script -

- Rs. 200/- per full paper (theory) of 100 marks and Rs. 100/- per full paper (theory) of 50 Marks is to be deposited with the application form as application fees of Review of Result for PGDGC/PGDYE Candidates.
- Maximum one paper (PGDGC/PGDYE) is allowed to be reviewed.
- Marks may be reduced, remain unchanged or increased as a result of Review.
- Post Review result will stand final irrespective of whether the marks are more or less.
- The candidate must submit his original mark-sheet with the application of Review.
- After Review (if the marks changed) the old Mark-sheet/Grade Card will be discarded and replaced by a new one.
