BAND AND MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS (BMI)

Course Description:

Certificate course will give trainees a basic understanding of the selected musical instrument. Trainees will get a lot of hands-on experience in sight-reading and practices as well. After completing a certificate program, trainees may be able to play the selected musical instrument in an efficient way. This Certificate course is for individual prospective teachers who are interested in playing band musical instruments. In this course, prospective teachers will develop the skills needed to be professional performing musicians. The beginning band class offers the trainees an opportunity to learn to play a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument.

The trainees and the teacher will collaborate to choose one instrument from the woodwind family (flute, oboe, clarinet, saxophone, bassoon), brass instruments (trumpet, French horn, trombone, euphonium, tuba), or percussion (drum and bell kit) for the trainee to study for the entire course.

Physical characteristics, personality traits, prior musical experience, instrument availability, student interest, and the need for balanced instrumentation within the band will all be considered in instrument selection. The goal of the class is to give the trainees the fundamental skills needed to continue their development in the advanced band and/or in the Saugus band. Trainees will have the opportunity to perform music in various concerts and professionally adjudicated festivals.

Participation in performances outside the college day is highly suggested in the class. Members of the beginning band are also encouraged to seek private lessons and grow individually through solo performances and auditioned ensembles. On the occasion of National Youth Day on January 12th and International Mother Language Day on February 21st, a colourful procession is organized at the nearby Main Campus Ramakrishna Mission Belur Math. By learning this course on Band and Musical Instruments, students can play an important role in this procession by performing their various musical instruments skillfully.
