Guidelines for the Authors:

Samskr̥tacintanam, a single-blinded peer reviewed international research journal of Sanskrit, is being published by Ramakrishna Mission Sikshanamandira since September 2014. Having published its 6 previous volumes, we're most delighted in the fact that we are going to publish its 7th volume (Volume-VIII). It is also a pleasing occasion to state that this journal was under UGC Care List from January, 2023 to October 2023.

For publication of the **Volume-VIII** of Samskr̥tacintanam Journal we are inviting original research articles from the authors. The detailed instructions for submitting the articles are as follows:

1. Samskr̥tacintanam accepts original research articles not published elsewhere, containing new facts on any discipline of Sanskrit or new interpretation of existing knowledge. In this regard, the author/s must fill the '**Author's Declaration Form**' ([Author Declaration Form Link](#)) and submit the scanned copy.
2. Articles must be typed in single column with double spacing in A4 size pages (using figure legends, footnotes or endnotes, literature cited, etc.). The responsibility of accuracy of cited literature has to be borne by the author/s. Margins on all sides should be at least one inch. The pages of the article should be numbered consecutively.
3. The research articles should be written in English or Sanskrit. The article should not exceed 4000 words. Research articles must be in the appropriate research format. Please use Only Unicode Fonts (Size 12) for Devanagari script and IAST (transliteration scheme) for Sanskrit words in roman script (for articles that are written in English). No fonts other than Unicode will be accepted.

4. Articles must be submitted in both **PDF and MS Word** format. The articles will be accepted for review towards publication on the first come first serve basis. Only one article will be accepted from an author for this volume.
5. On the first page, title of the article, name of author, author's affiliation and institutional address with PIN code, email-id, and an abstract of 150 – 200 words are to be clearly written. In case there are two or more authors, the corresponding authors' names and addresses are also to be specified.
6. Abstract must be supported with Keywords. **Abstract and Keywords must be written in English, even if the original writing is in Sanskrit.** Main body of the article **with title** should start from the second page and **must not contain the name/s of the author/s** (as the present journal conducts single-blinded peer review).
7. Main body of the article should contain sections and subsections. New paragraphs should be indicated by clear indentation. Quoted passages longer than three lines should be indented throughout.
8. Single foreign words and phrases should be italicized (for articles written in English). In-text references should be mentioned as: author, year of publication and page: e.g. (Sengupta 1951, p.39), (Gupta and Goel 2005, p.119).
9. Author must have an Orcid Id (<https://orcid.org/>) and the Id must be mentioned in the First page of the article.
10. References in MLA format should be arranged alphabetically and should be given at the end of the article.

To submit an article author/s are required to submit the Google Form available in the Website ([Google Form Link](#)). No correspondence through post/email will be accepted.
