STUDENT WELFARE POLICY



Student Welfare Policy:

Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission - the worldwide spiritual organisation with the motto of 'For the Salvation of Own and For the Benefit to Others' - through its practice of selfless service to all beings as a means to salvation of the individual has marked an epoch in social service sector since its inception. This college being a unit of such an organisation certainly extends its empathetic support to needy students without any discrimination through financial assistance, free tuition, study materials and by various other means whenever possible within its rules and ethics. The Alumni Association actively and enthusiastically engages in this regard. The parent body too extends its support and encouragement in this cause thoroughly. The policies followed by the institution in this regard follows:

1. The College has a dedicated committee named Student Welfare Committee to handle the issues of Student Welfare. It consists of the principal, the hostel super and members of the faculty. The number of Faculty members belonging to SC/ST/OBC or minority community forms a significant part of the members to ensure non discrimination. The committee meets at least twice a year to consider the status and need of all students who need assistance and further evaluates their decision after taking the guardians of the concerned students in confidence. Thereafter, considering the resolution of this committee the college authority provides the type and degree of assistance to the needy students - the whole mechanism being permissible under government, institutional and the organisational rules.
2. The Student Welfare Committee also frequently holds awareness camps on government scholarships, financial assistance, grants and so on and actively encourages needy students to avail them.
3. Apart from the said committee there is a separate Hostel Committee as well formed under the statutory rules of the parent body. The Hostel Committee also consists of diverse staff members with the major part being formed by the hostel staff. Faculty members are also included in this committee. This committee further looks after the needs of residential students challenged financially, physically or otherwise and proceeds in the same manner to assist them as much as possible.
4. Any financial assistance is thoroughly and minutely audited and the official records are kept in standard formats so that there is no discrepancy or violation.
