Subject :- Second Five Year Plan - Secondary Education - Improvement and Expansion of Teachers' Training Facilities (including training in guidance) - Establishment of a Training College under the management of Ramakrishna Mission Saradapitha, Belur.

Reference :- His U.O. No. 889 dated the 26th October, 1957.

In conformity with the Principles for Improvement and Expansion of Teachers' Training Facilities for Secondary Education, the State Govt. have formulated proposals for the setting up of Teachers Training Colleges for Secondary Schools under the programme for 1957-58. The Government of India in the Ministry of Education in their letter No. F.4-4-57-C.U., dated the 5th February, 1957 have agreed to bear 60% of the cost of the scheme.

2. The scheme as drawn up by the Director of Public Instruction, in conformity with the approved principles has been carefully considered by Government and they are now pleased to approve of the establishment of a teachers' Training College under the auspices of the Ramakrishna Mission Saradapitha, Belur as a sponsored institution at Belur in the district of Howrah.

The College will be conducted as a sponsored institution by a Governing Body constituted with the approval of Government. A separate order will issue in due course in this respect.

3. Sanction of Government is now accorded to the establishment of a Teachers' Training College under the auspices of the Ramakrishna Mission Saradapitha Belur as a sponsored institution at the non-recurring and recurring scales of expenditure as shown in the annexure.

To start with 100 trainees including teachers deputed from the recognised and aided Secondary Schools may be admitted. The training provide in the institution will be free and 60 stipends each of the value of Rs. 40/- per month may be granted to deserving trainees. Approved teachers deputed for training from aided schools may also be eligible for stipends in addition to their deputation salary which they should receive from their schools concerned.

4. The College may be affiliated upto B.T. standard in the following subject :-

- i) Principles of Education including Educational Psychology.
- ii) History of Education.
- iii) General Methods, School Education, School Organisation and School Hygiene.
- iv) Methods of teaching in - (a) English (b) Bengali (c) Sanskrit (d) History (e) Mathematics (f) Geography (g) Hygiene (h) Art and Craft (i) Primary and Infant School subjects.
- v) Essay and Composition in Bengali or English
- vi) The College may further be affiliated in the following subjects:
 - a) Mental and Educational Measurements
 - b) Mental Hygiene and Child Guidance.
 - c) Methods and Organisation in Nursery School and Montessori

Practice Teaching of the trainees of the College may be done in the near about institutions as may be selected with the approval of the Director of Public Instruction. Each of the non-Government Schools selected for Practice Teaching may be paid a sum of Rs. 200/- Annually for superintendence of Practice Teaching.

5. Immediate steps may be taken so that the College may start functioning with effect from the next academic session.

The construction works approved for the College as shown in the annexure will be undertaken according to the plans and estimates to be approved by the Project Officer-cum-Executive Engineer of the Education Directorate.

6. The Director of Public Instruction is authorised to release the non-recurring grant of Rs. 4.31 lakhs (Rupees four lakhs and thirty one thousand) only as detailed below during the current financial year.

The balance of the grants will be released on progress of work.

7. The staff and expenditure that the college should maintain as detailed in the annexure. The annual recurring grant as may be paid to the college should be on the basis of staff and expenditure and be phased as follows :-

8. The Director of Public Instruction is authorised to take immediate steps for implementing the scheme and to release an advance grant to the authorities of the college to enable them to incur expenditure as may be considered necessary in the initial stages on staff and other expenditure. The advance grant may be adjusted when the final grant will be paid in the next half of the year.

9. The charge involved during the current financial year will be met from the provision under the head "W. Development Schemes - Second Five Year Plan - Secondary Education - Improvement and Expansion of Teachers Training Facilities (including training in guidance) - Grant-in-aid etc." in the 37-Education Budget.

10. The Pay and Accounts Officer (Education), West Bengal and the Accountant General, West Bengal, have been informed.



Memorandum

The matter of restructuring of service conditions and other benefits for Government approved Part Time teachers (PTTs), Government approved Contractual Whole time teachers (CWTTs) and Guest teachers, in any nomenclature, engaged in different Government/ Government aided colleges in the State of West Bengal up to 13.07.2019, was under active consideration of the State Government for sometimes past. After careful consideration of the matter, the Governor is hereby pleased, in supersession of all previous orders in this regard, to restructure the service conditions along with the change of nomenclature of the aforesaid category of teachers commensurate with their qualifications and period of service rendered in the following manner:—

1. Part Time Teachers, Contractual Whole Time Teachers and Guest Teachers having qualification for being appointed as teachers in the colleges as prescribed by the University Grants Commission and as followed by the West Bengal College Service Commission, on the date of issuance of this order, will be renamed as **State Aided College Teacher, Category-I**, and will be entitled for the following remuneration:
 - a. Rs. 31,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college less than 10 years;
 - b. Rs. 35,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college more than 10 years;
2. Part Time Teachers, Contractual Whole Time Teachers and Guest Teachers don't having qualification for being appointed as teachers in the colleges as prescribed by the University Grants Commission, and as followed by the West Bengal College Service Commission on the date of issuance of this order, will be renamed as **State Aided College Teacher, Category-II** and will be entitled for the following remuneration:
 - c. Rs. 20,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college less than 10 years;
 - d. Rs.25,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college more than 10 years;
3. Remuneration of existing Government approved PTTs and CWTTs, who are getting higher remuneration at present, shall be protected.
4. Remuneration of above mentioned category of teachers will be enhanced @ 3% of the total remuneration per year on 1st July of every year.


5. Such category of teachers will be entitled for Rs. 5.00 Lakh (Five Lakh) only on attaining the age of 60 years, provided the teacher concerned has rendered service for a period not less than 10 years.
6. State Aided College Teacher, Category-II, on acquirement of UGC qualifications subsequently will be considered as State Aided College Teacher, Category-I with effect from the date of acquiring such qualification, subject to the approval of DPI, West Bengal.
7. General conditions in respect of approval of all the state aided College teachers mentioned above:-
 - I. Fresh letter of engagement will be issued by the college authority to all category of teachers mentioned hereinabove after obtaining approval of the Director of Public Instructions, West Bengal.
 - II. Notional vacancies are to be created to accommodate all State Aided College Teachers who are engaged as per 7(I) above and these posts would be treated as personal and supernumerary ones.
 - III. Both the above two category of teachers (i.e. State Aided College Teacher, Category-I & Category-II) will be allowed to continue their engagement till they attain the age of 60 years. However, service of any particular teacher of above categories may be terminated by the Governing Body, with the approval of the State Government for non-performance, incapacitation, delinquency, misconduct, involvement in any criminal case or any other culpable offence, in such manner as may be prescribed by the State Government.
 - IV. The above category of teachers will be required to take classes, along with works related to examination etc, as per the following schedule:-
 - a. State Aided College Teacher, Category-I: 15 hours per week.
 - b. State Aided College Teacher, Category-II: 15 hours per week.
 - V. The benefit of this Order shall be allowed to the Part Time Teachers, Contractual Whole Time Teachers and Guest Teachers who were engaged in the college on or before 13.07.2019.
 - VI. If required, the above category of teachers may be deployed in any other Govt. aided colleges in the interest of public service.
 - VII. **The financial benefit will however, be effective from the 1st day of January, 2020.**
