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Proceedings of the meeting of Curriculum Framing-cum-Planning Committee (CFPC) held on 21st July 2022 at 1 p.m. at college conference hall.

1. Discussion on modification of syllabus

There was a suggestion regarding Curriculum revision for the forthcoming B.Ed. and M.Ed. programme of 2022-24. The suggestions revision are as follows:-

For B.Ed. programme:

- i) Course 121, 2nd half, Education in India (Post-Independence), in Unit III (f) NEP-2020 is to be included.
- ii) Course 127, School attachment programme, Out of 3 weeks, 2 weeks for LD & Micro-teaching Skill Practice and 1 week for school visit for microteaching is to be held.

For M.Ed. programme:

- i) Course 221, History of Education in India, in Unit V(h), 'Draft NPE 2016/ NEP 2019' is to be replaced by 'NEP-2020'.
- ii) Course 223, Teacher Education, in Practicum the word "Teacher Education" is to be replaced by "Education".
- iii) Course 226, Proposal for Dissertation is to be conducted instead of Internship (1st Part).
- iv) Course 235, Visual and Performing Arts in Education, in Unit V (a) "Kaththak" and "Odishi" are to be added.
- v) Course 239, Internship (1st Part) in Teachers Education Institution is to be included in lieu of Proposal for Dissertation.
- vi) Course 244, the title of the course is to be written as "Internship (2nd Part) (Teaching Observation)".

After the discussion, aforesaid revision of curriculum of B.Ed. 2022-24 and M.Ed. 2022-24 were resolved to recommend to the Board of Studies and Academic Council for approval.

2. Planning of curricular transactions

The members of the committee discussed in detail the curricular transactions and planning related to the impending academic session. Based on the discussions and feedback received from peer teachers of the college, the following curricular planning calendar and transaction time table were finalized and approved.

3. Feedback from previous session

Feedback from different stakeholders was received and discussed in detail. It was decided that the same should be placed before the IQAC as well as the BoS.
