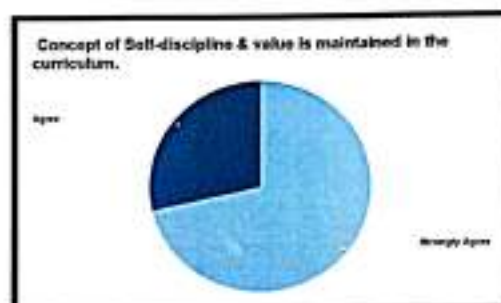


**ANALYSIS OF CURRICULUM

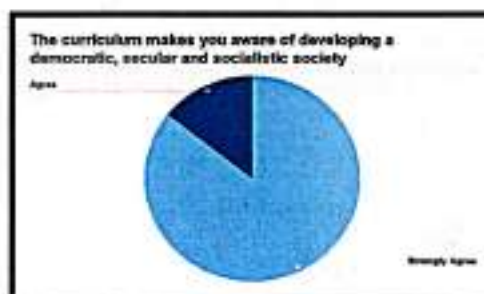

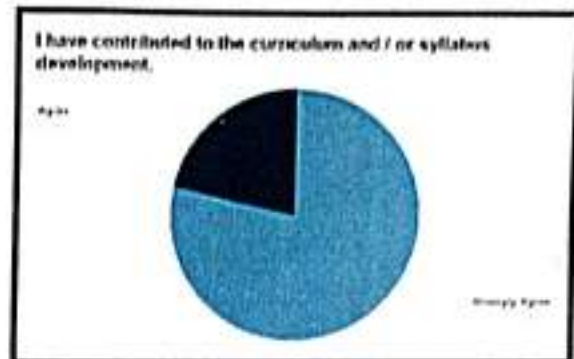


## ANALYSIS OF TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM (ACADEMIC SESSION: 2020-2021)
