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The above schools have helped us provide a platform to our B.Ed. trainees to do their internships. We usually send a letter, duly signed by the Principal, requesting permission from the Head of School above. To conduct this long-term internship program, the teachers of these schools come to our college and engage in various discussions with mentor teachers and principals. At this time, the college informed them well about the responsibilities and duties of the students during the internship period. Mentor teachers of our college visit the schools before sending the students and chalk out how the entire internship process will be done by discussing with HM and other subject teachers.

Trainees are sent to said schools with their formal consent through prayer letters sent from our college. Our students do their internship for 16 weeks in two phases each of 8 weeks and during the internship the respective school teachers observe their teaching, evaluate the learning design and give feedback. The mentor teachers of each school consider the evaluation of the teachers of that school for the trainees assigned to them during their evaluation.

In-Service Teachers' Training Programme

Ramakrishna Mission Sikshanamandira was established in the year 1958 in close proximity of the sacred precincts of Belur Math as a residential Teacher Training Institute. Since its inception it has been working tirelessly to train the budding teachers to propagate Swami Vivekananda's 'Man making and Character Building Education'.

In 1986 the Indian Parliament passed the National Policy on Education of which teacher education was a significant component. The Programme of Action (1986, 1992) stipulated that there will be a Central Scheme to restructure and reorganise teacher education programmes. Recognising the need of various training programmes for the in-service teachers, it was proposed that some selected Secondary Teacher Education Institutions will be upgraded into College of Teacher Education (CTEs) and Institutions of Advanced Studies in Education (IASEs) to frequently organise training programmes for the in-service school teachers to boost-up their teaching efficiency with up-to-date content and pedagogical knowledge as well.

It is of great pride and privilege that our college was chosen and upgraded to a College of Teacher Education (CTE) by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt, of India in the year 2001. Since then our college has organised numerous training programmes for the in-service school teachers with the financial aid from MHRD, Govt. of India till the year 2011. In those training programmes, the participants who came from various Govt. / Govt.- aided Secondary / Higher Secondary schools spread across different districts of West Bengal expressed univocally how the training has helped them to rejuvenate their teaching skills, through providing courage and motivation, updating their content knowledge of their respective subjects, upgrading the pedagogical knowledge and skill by acquainting them with the new methodologies of teaching strategies and so on and so forth. Unfortunately, the funding for such training programmes was discontinued from 2012. Although there was a great need and demand for such training programmes among the in-service school teachers, Sikshanamandira had no other choice but to stop organising such programmes.

In 2018, when the college was applying for the RUSA 2.0 Component 8 Grant, remembering the need and demand of such training programmes from the stakeholders, the then Principal of the college, Revered Swami Tattwasaranandaji Maharaj incorporated this type of 16 In-Service Teachers Training Programmes (ISTTPs) in the RUSA 2.0 Action Plan under Human Resource Development (Soft component) section.

Following the guidelines of RUSA 2.0 DPR, 12 (twelve) ISTTPs (each of 6 days duration) were conducted from 29th August 2022 which spanned nearly 5 months and concluded on 30th January 2023. The detailed reports of subject-wise ISTTPs are as follows:

Report:

Dr. Abhijit Guha, an Associate Professor at Ramakrishna Mission Sikshanamandira, orchestrated a 6-day In-Service Teachers' Training on Value Education and Educational Management. - b) We trace back to your first communication with us via mail (See attached Screenshot Annexure - IV) where it was clearly mentioned that an allocation of Rs. 3, 188, 000 was approved for the college.
- c) Further, according to the release order [No.F50-148/2019 (IC) dated 11 Dec, 2019 (Attached Annexure - V)] that the payment of grant of Rs. 1594000 is the first instalment towards the PARAMARSH scheme.

Please provide clarity regarding the same, because despite all the hardships faced due to the pandemic, our assistance and paperwork of mentee colleges towards NAAC accreditation stays unhindered. Our plan to start various programmes will commence as soon as we receive government directives to reopen our college and start our regular activities.
