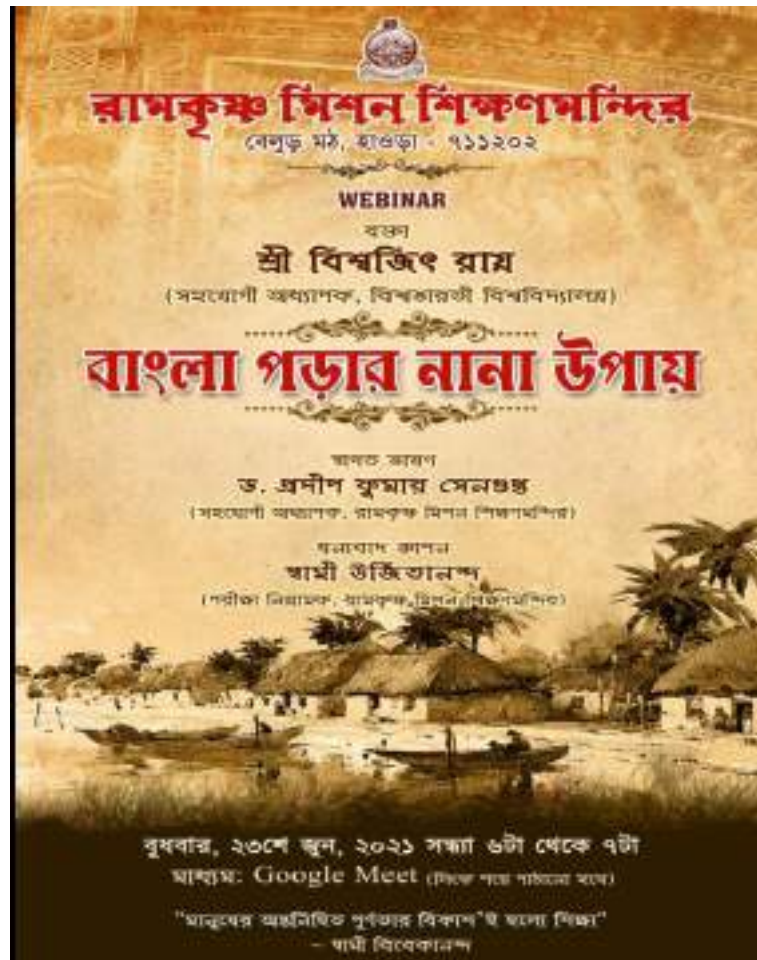
### 3. Webinar: “Bangla Porar Nana Upaay”



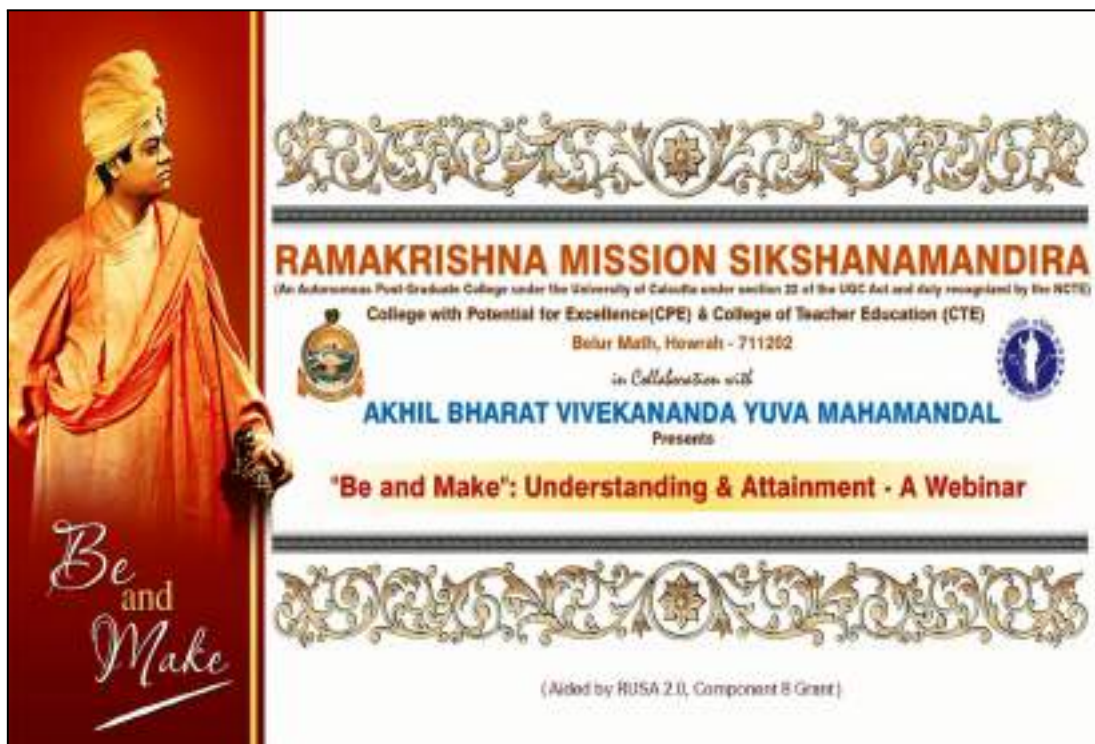
## 10. “Be and Make” Webinar: Understanding and Attainment
