
Webinar on World Environment Day 2023: "Environment, Behaviour and the Future


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Observation of National Education Day: "Changing Course, Transforming Education"



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
Seminar on "Ground Water: Making the Invisible Visible"






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7-Day National Workshop on Inscriptions and Languages in Indian Coins






