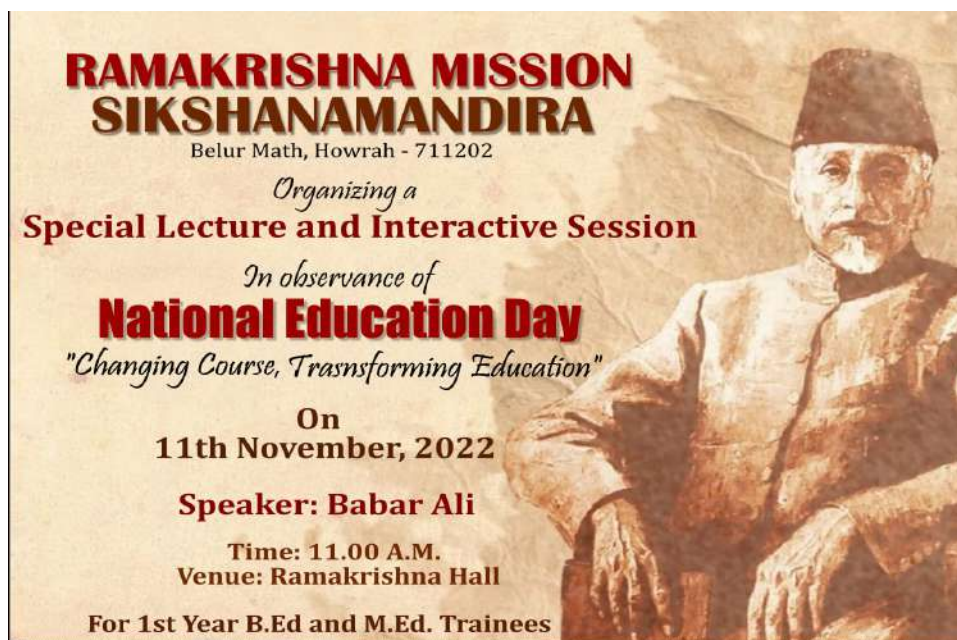

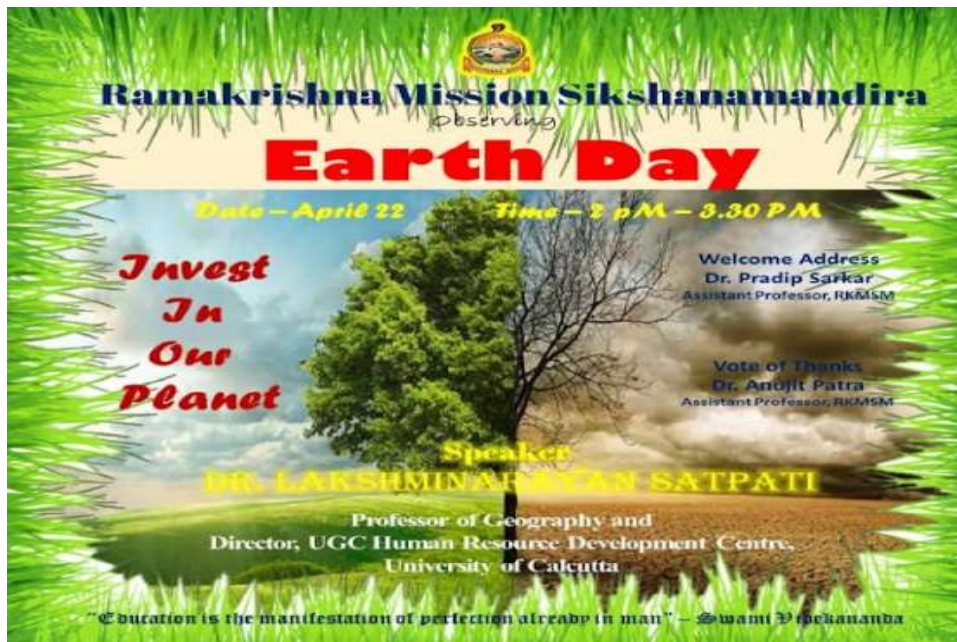
World Earth Day Seminar: Invest in Our Planet

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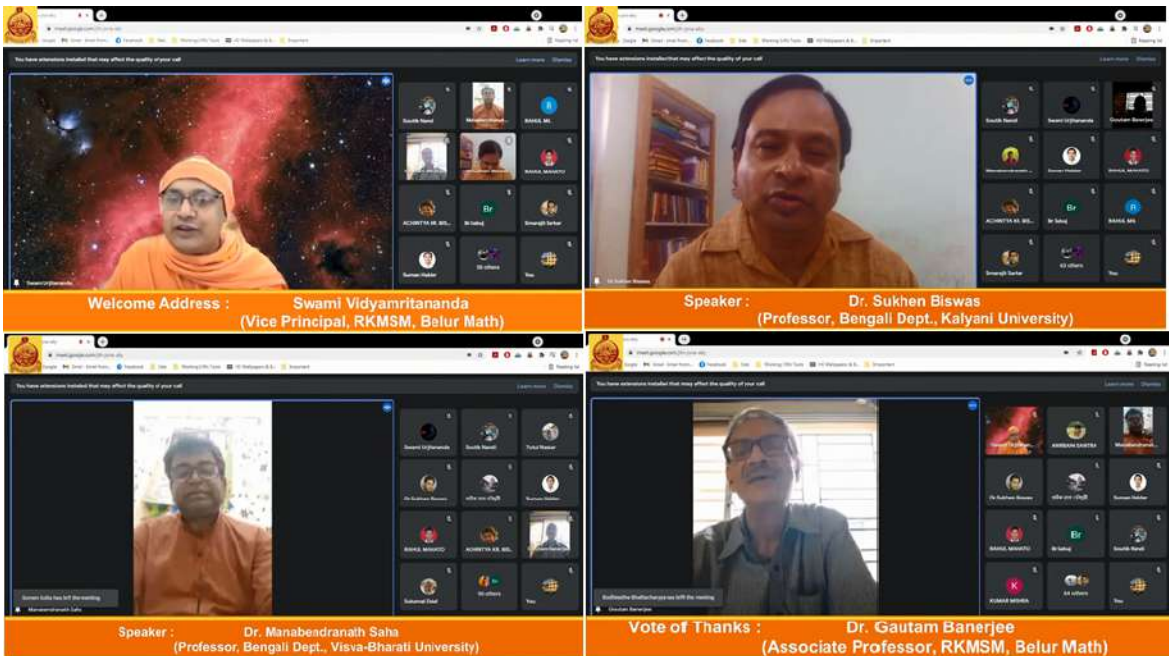


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Webinar: “Bhabonay Satyajit” – Commemorating Satyajit Ray
